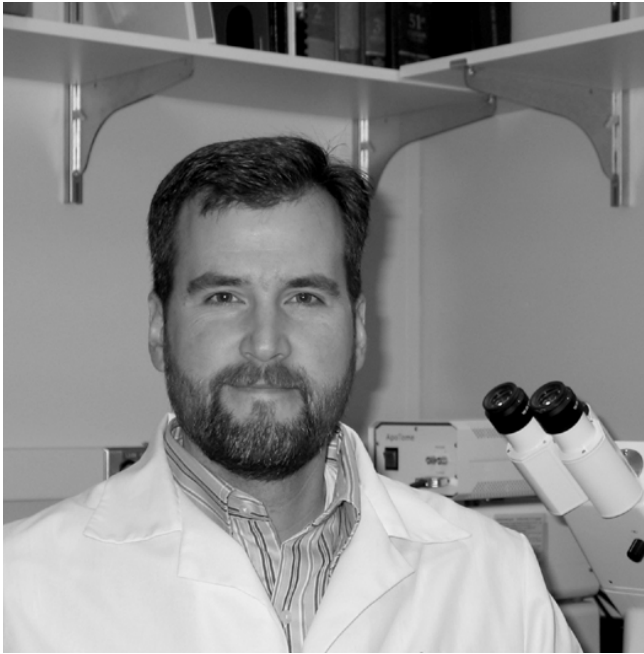

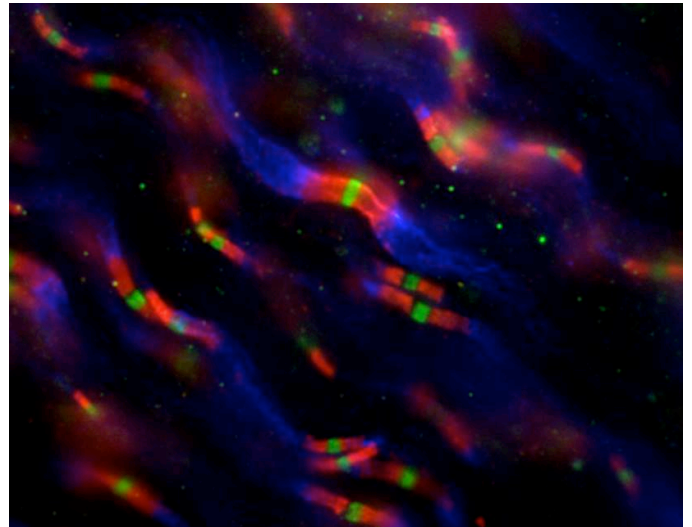

The functional organization of axons in health and disease

Axons are organized into discrete functional domains, including axon initial segments and, in myelinated axons, nodes of Ranvier. I will discuss the molecular and cellular mechanisms responsible for assembling these domains, and I will discuss the consequences of disease and injury that disrupt these essential axonal domains.
